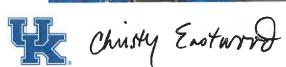

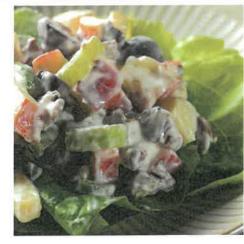


### Apple Cranberry Waldorf Salad

Servings:8 Serving Size:1 cup

#### Ingredients:

- 1 cup chopped Granny Smith apples
- 1 cup chopped Red Delicious apples
- 1 cup diced celery
- 1 cup halved seedless green grapes
- 1½ cups dried cranberries
- ½ cup chopped walnuts
- 8 ounces nonfat vanilla yogurt
- 2 tablespoons honey
- ¼ teaspoon cinnamon



#### **Directions:**

Combine apples and celery in a medium-sized bowl. Add grapes, cranberries and walnuts. Stir. In a separate bowl, add yogurt, honey and cinnamon. Stir together and pour over the fruit mixture. Cover and chill before serving.

#### **APPLE FACTS**

Apples are ready to harvest from late summer to late October, with September being the best time to pick

them. However, different varieties of apples ripen at different times, and the climate varies the harvest time each year. Some cultivars are ready as early as late August, and others aren't mature until October or even November.

- Apples are a good source of fiber and vitamin C. They also contain antioxidants, like vitamin E, and polyphenols, contributing to the fruit's numerous health benefits.
- Apples are particularly filling due to their high fiber and water content.
- Apples promote heart health in several ways because they're high in soluble fiber, which helps lower cholesterol.



• Eating apples is linked to a lower risk of type 2 diabetes, potentially due to their polyphenol content. The type of fiber found in apples improves your gut-friendly bacteria, which may be why the fruit is thought to help protect against chronic diseases.

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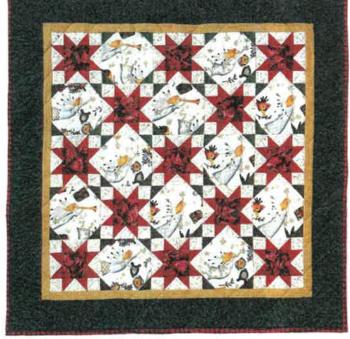

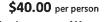
